

#### MARY, MOTHER OF THE CHURCH

#### Summary

 It is God's exceptional love for Mary that is at the basis of her Divine Motherhood.

(qq. 1-3)

 The Blessed Virgin has truly the right to the title of Mother of God.

(qq. 4-7)

 At what moment did she become, freely and willingly, the Mother of God?

(qq. 8-10)

 Just as the Incarnation is the beginning of all the graces that Jesus received, so the Divine Motherhood is the beginning of all the graces that Mary received.

# True Love for the Blessed Virgin Is Inseparable from Love for God

### 65. Does love for the Blessed Virgin lead away from love for God?

No. If the Blessed Virgin is a path to God, the more we love God, the more will we love the Blessed Virgin. Hence, true love for the Blessed Virgin must always increase.

## 66. Can we not love God without loving the Blessed Virgin?

No. It is impossible to love God without loving the Blessed Virgin once we know that she is truly the Mother of God.

### 67. Is it necessary to think expressly of the Blessed Virgin every time we think of God?

No. The Blessed Virgin, even if she is not named, is happy about every prayer that rises to God.

### 68. Does true devotion to the Blessed Virgin run counter to the adoration due to Jesus?

Not at all. In fact, we see that wherever devotion to Mary is given up, faith in the Divinity of Christ tends to disappear.
