Alternative Prayer

Almighty and ever-present Father, your watchful care reaches from end to end and orders all things in such power that even the tensions and the tragedies of sin cannot frustrate your loving plans.

Help us to embrace your will, give us the strength to follow your call, so that your truth may live in our hearts

and reflect peace to those who believe in your love. We ask this in the name of Jesus the Lord.

All-powerful and ever-living God, direct your love that is within us, that our efforts in the name of your Son may bring mankind to unity and peace.

We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

Alternative Prayer

Almighty Father, the love you offer always exceeds the furthest expression of our human longing, for you are greater than the human heart.
