Peace to this house and all here.

Or:

The peace of the Lord be with you.

Other formulas of greeting, nos. 230 and 231.

69. If appropriate, the Priest takes holy water and sprinkles the sick person and the room, saying this formula:

May this water be a memorial of the Baptism we have received and remind us of Christ, who redeemed us by his Passion and Resurrection.

70. Then he addresses those present in these or similar words:

Dear brothers and sisters, the Lord Jesus Christ is present among us gathered in his name.

In the Gospel the sick came to him, pleading to be healed,

and he himself suffered so much for us. Through the Apostle James he gives us the command:

"Is anyone among you sick?
They should summon the Priests of
the Church,
who should pray over them
and anoint them with oil in the name of
the Lord.
